

Madhapar Community – Non Workshop Rules and Regulations

- If there is a need, ANY INDIVIDUAL OR WHOLE ITEM from outside of Madhapar Community members performing on the stage will only be at the discretion of Madhapar Community workshop committee. Of course, priority and preferential benefits will be given to the members. The decision will be taken by majority vote within Madhapar Community workshop committee.
- Any commercial organisation who wishes to perform on the stage to promote their business at the annual function, a fee (to be decided) will be payable to Madhapar Community. Madhapar Community workshop committee will vet the program for suitability and quality.
- Non-commercial or voluntary organisation will be allowed to perform free of charge only at the discretion of Madhapar Community workshop committee. Rule 1 will still apply.
- On certain occasions, Madhapar community workshop Committee may hire and pay to professional entertainers or organisations. Budget for the performance will be forward to main committee and will have to be approved in advance.
- These rules apply to non-members only.

Registration

All details of the song, participants and choreographer must be filled in.

- The audio material must be clearly labelled.
- Workshop committee must receive completed forms by 30th June, by emailing Manjulaben Khokhani mkhokhani@hotmail.com or Shantaben Siani shanta_siani@hotmail.com.
- Any participants under 6 years old may participate, providing she/he meet the quality of the item and will have to come and show their item at the Madhapar Community workshop. The committee will notify you of the date. The item presented on this day, will be approved by the workshop choreographers and workshop team and their decisions will be the final.
- Please indicate on the form if you suffer from any medical condition/allergy. **This is a safety requirement.**

Madhapar Community will not be taking any liabilities what so ever during the workshop rehearsal.

Non-workshop groups

- The song to be used by the non-workshop group must be selected and given to workshop committee by 30th June. If a song duplication with the workshop item, then you will be asked to change and give an alternative song.
- If the program is theme based then your item will be selected accordingly.
- Non-workshop groups will be contacted to present their item at the workshop at least twice before the Grand rehearsal. The group will be given 2 weeks prior notice. If the item is very poor then the assurance will be required that it will be improved by the Grand Rehearsal day. By second rehearsal, poor standard of items will be withdrawn.

The complete item with the all the participants must be shown on the Grand Rehearsal.

- If for any reason that the group decides to cancel the item then workshop committee must be notified immediately so that the order of grouping can be changed.
- Workshop committee will decide the order of performance on the Annual function.
- Costumes selected must be appropriate for the theme and the AGM. Workshop committee may decide to withdraw the item on the day if it is not appropriate.
